

Recall Sam Adams Collector Instructions

STEPS for collecting signatures:

1) **BEFORE** you let people sign, always ask:

- ***Are you an active registered Portland voter living in Multnomah county?***

Hint: If people do not know if they are a Portland voter ask them if they have ever got a ballot to vote for Portland Mayor.

“No” to this question makes them ineligible to sign. You can give people voter registrations, and tell them to go get registered, and that they can sign the petition after their voter registration card is received by county elections.

2) **BEFORE** you give people a pen to sign your petition, explain the following to ensure you get a valid signature:

- ***“sign here as you did on your ballot” (point the spot out with your pen)***
- ***“date here mm/dd/yy” (point to the date spot and say clearly “don’t spell out the month, use numbers, please. “***
- ***“print your name legibly here so the City Auditor can verify your signature” (point with your pen),***
- ***“print your address legibly and include the word Portland all spelled out. There’s not a lot of space so please write small but clearly if you can. Thank you so much.”***

3) **AFTER** completing steps (1) and (2), THEN hand them the pen and petition. People scrawl, run out of space, forget they live in Gresham, etc

DOS and DONTS for circulators:

- DON'T correct anything in the 10 signatory fields-if a person makes a mistake (or actually turns out to be from Gresham in spite of answering yes to your question about their residency), make them draw a line through and initial their mistake.
- DON'T write anything in the bottom section which is for the county election officials. Your space is only the **circulator certification** area.
- DON'T sign and date your circulator section at the bottom until you review all of the dates of the signers on your petition! If your date is before a signer's date this is an invalid petition.
- DO fill in all spaces in the **circulator certification** section when ready to turn in your petition(s).
- DO make sure you have printed the front AND the back of the petition on ONE sheet of 20 pound uncoated white paper. The petition is invalid if only one side is printed or on the wrong type of paper.
- DO give 'Thank You' cards to all that sign. Let them know that the campaign needs their help.
- DO return your signature sheets as soon as they get filled out to:

- DO sign and return the Volunteer Signature Collector Agreement on the next page to the campaign before you collect signatures. This is vital to avoid expensive legal challenges from Adams and to make sure all your signatures count.

Community to Recall Sam Adams Volunteer Signature Collector Agreement

All volunteers who wish to collect signatures to recall Sam Adams must review and sign this agreement.

This agreement ensures the integrity of the campaign by verifying that you are collecting signatures in accordance with the campaigns ethical construct, you have proper identification in accordance with OAR 165-014-0270 and that the chief petitioner (Jasun Wurster) has reviewed with you all of the requirements and guidelines prior to you circulating the recall petition PDX001.

Ethical and civic reason for collecting signatures:

As a volunteer signature collector for this recall you agree that you will only collect signatures from registered Portland voters who want Sam Adams recalled for the reasons listed on the SEL 350. You agree **not** to collect signatures from individuals with goals that are to remove Sam Adams from office based on sexual orientation or religious social conservative reasons.

Verification of volunteer signature collectors:

You have verified your current Oregon voter registration has your following name of:

If you are not a registered Oregon voter you have provided the chief petitioner with an alternate exemplar in accordance with OAR 165-014-0270 (5)(d)(C).

Review of requirements and guidelines with the chief petitioner:

The chief petitioner has reviewed all the requirements and guidelines with you as a volunteer circulatory prior to you collecting signatures. This information has been conveyed by the chief petitioner in person, on the phone, or via other electronic means such as a web site or email.

Any questions you have have about the legal responsibilities and ethical expectations about being a volunteer signature collector have been answered by the chief petitioner.
